

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – September 2009

1. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in August 2009: 11,856,000 barrels per day (August 2008: 13,118,000 b/d). [API]
2. Total imports in August 2009 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 62.8 percent (August 2008: 68.0 percent). [API]
3. Persian Gulf petroleum imports in June 2009 as a percentage of total imports: 15.9 percent (June 2008: 21.3 percent). [DOE]
4. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for the week ending September 4, 2009: \$68.41 [DOE]
5. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in July 2009 for a barrel of crude oil: \$63.81. [DOE]
6. U.S. crude oil production in August 2009: 5,197,000 b/d (of which 573,000 b/d was Alaskan) (August 2008: 4,894,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in August 2009: 1,974,000 b/d (August 2008: 1,815,000 b/d). [API]
7. U.S. marketed natural gas production in June 2009: 60.5 billion cubic feet per day (June 2008: 59.5 billion cf/d). [DOE]
8. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in August 2009: 9,230,000 b/d (August 2008: 9,134,000 b/d). [API]
9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in August 2009: 3,540,000 b/d (August 2008: 3,659,000 b/d). [API]
10. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in August 2009: 18,867,000 b/d (August 2008: 19,272,000 b/d). [API]
