CEHS Charter

- Address environmental, health, safety and emergency preparedness and response issues impacting pipeline transportation and associated facilities
- Encompasses industry activities that pose risks to people and the environment, including those regulated by OSHA, EPA and parallel state agencies
- Coordinate with API Operations and Technical Committee on DOT/PHMSA issues

CEHS Charter

CEHS will accomplish its charter through the following:

- Provide forum for exchange of EHS information
- Maintain broad cross-section of knowledgeable industry representatives
- Assess industry-regulator relationships and foster improved working relationships; assess industry compliance
- Establish and maintain coordination and liaison with other API groups on EHS matters
- Provide industry perspectives and comments on proposed EHS legislation
- Review EHS issues and make recommendations for actions and projects to the API Pipeline Committee.
